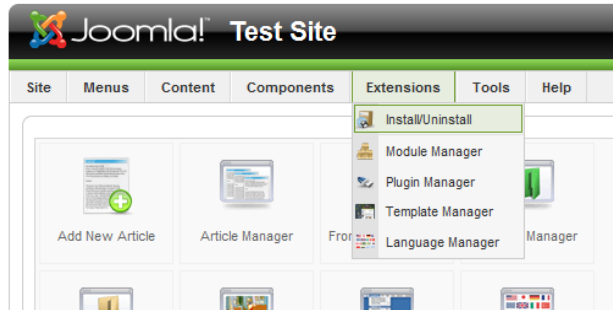

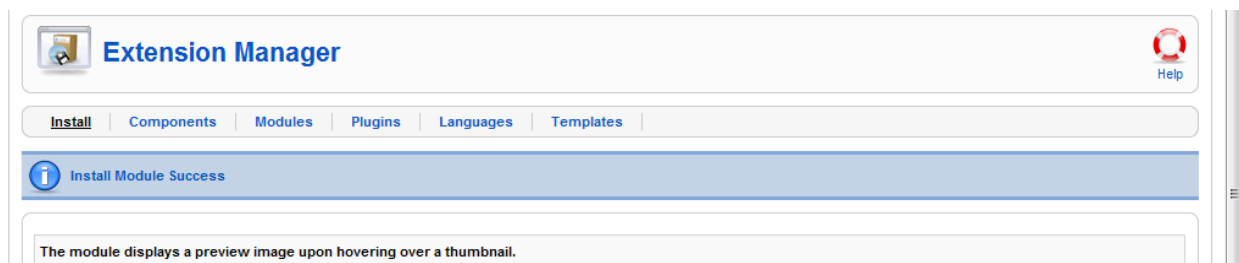
2. Go to the Install/Uninstall Section under Extensions.

Hyperlink: This is the webpage to which the page would link.


Thumbnail: This is the initial picture which appears on the page.

Preview: This is the image which pop ups on mouse over.

NOTE: Incase relative path names do not work, you could also try with absolute path names, e.g. Instead of /modules/mod_t2dajaxpreview/image_preview/preview_unknown.gif

Number of Module Instances on Same Page: This parameter can be used to specify how many instances of the module one is using on the same page. It should be constant across all the module instances used on the same page, e.g. if you're using three instances of the module on the same page, then this parameter should be set 3 for all the three module instances.
